<p>Facility:</p>	<p>North Charleston Aquatic Center 8610 Patriot Blvd, North Charleston, SC 29420</p> <p>Indoor 20-lane 25-yard competition pool with a moveable bulkhead and 8-lane 25-yard warm down pool with non-turbulent lane lines. Bleacher seating for over 1000 is available but will be limited due to Covid-19. Spectators may bring chairs and tents to use on the outside patios and grass areas. Chairs, food, and coolers are not permitted on the pool deck. The water depth of the competition course is seven (7) feet, measured from one (1) meter to five (5) meters, on the starting end of the course, and seven (7) feet, measured from one (1) meter to five (5) meters, at the turn end of the course. The water depth of the warm down course is six (6) feet, measured from one (1) meter to five (5) meters, on the starting end of the course, and four (4) feet, measured from one (1) meter to five (5) meters, at the turn end of the course. <p>Meet Format:</p>	<p>Meet Management reserves the right to adjust the number of heats and lanes, entry limits, and warm-up times based on the number of entries.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All events, except those noted on the itinerary and below, will be conducted as Preliminary/Final events with three heats of 10 returning for finals. The “C” for finals shall be a dedicated 16 & Under heat. Heats will be contested in finals in the following order; “C” (dedicated 16 & under heat), consolation “B” heat and championship “A” heat. • On Thursday the Women’s 1650 free and the Men’s 1000 free will be deck seeded and require a positive check-in 30 minutes before the start of session. • On Sunday the Women’s 1000 and the Men’s 1650 free will be contested as a timed finals event with the heats swum fastest to slowest at the end of preliminary session with the top heat each event being swum at finals. Swimmers have the option to declare AM or PM swim. • The 400 IM and 500 Freestyle events will be conducted as Prelim/Finals events. These events will be deck seeded and swum slowest to fastest with 2 circle seeded heats. There will be no ‘C’ final event for these events. • All relays will be at the end of Final Sessions. All relays will be deck seeded after positive check in on the day of the relay. Positive check in for relays at night will close at the end of the prelims session the day of the event. • All individual events 400 yards and longer will be deck seeded and require a positive check-in. Positive check-in will close thirty (30) minutes prior to the start of the session. • Seeding will be by SCY times, then SCM, followed by LCM times. • Relay teams must meet the relay standard with aggregate times, if using swimmers not qualified in an individual event. • Entry times may not be converted. • Deck entries for individual and relay events will not be permitted. • All USA Swimming registration numbers will be verified with the SWIMS registration database. • The host team will attempt to announce the names of swimmers in each “A” Championship Final heat prior to the start of the event. The Meet management committee will evaluate the timeline and determine whether names of swimmers in the “B” and “C” heats are announced when swimmers are behind the blocks or whether they will be announced as swimmers are in the water. • Meet management reserves the right to utilize two courses, up to 10 lanes each for competition for any events as described below. <p>The meet will be conducted according to this meet information and the SCLSC Policies and Procedures.</p>

<p>Scratch Rule:</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Any swimmer not reporting for or competing in an individual timed final event, a pre-seeded preliminary event in which finals will be competed, or a relay shall not be penalized. • Any swimmer who has been positively checked-in and after the heats have been seeded, and then fails to report will be barred from their next individual event. The application of this penalty shall pertain to the order in which the events are contested. • Any swimmer qualifying for a final in events in which preliminaries and finals are competed, who fails to swim in that final, shall be barred from all further competition for the remainder of the meet. • Exceptions for failure to compete – no penalty shall apply for failure to report or swim an event if: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The Referee is notified in event of illness or injury and accepts the proof thereof. - A swimmer qualifying for a final based upon the results of preliminaries notifies the Referee within thirty (30) minutes of the announcement of the qualifiers for that final event that they may not intend to compete and further declares their final intentions within thirty (30) minutes following their last individual preliminary event. - A swimmer qualifying for a final event, as a result of scratches following announcement of the qualifiers, based upon the results of preliminaries or failure of a qualifier to swim. - It is determined by the Referee that failure to compete is caused by circumstances beyond the control of the swimmer. <p>Scratch Procedures:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Swimmers who do not intend to swim an event or must scratch down to the three events per day limit (8 total for the meet) or need to make room for a time trial should be scratched by the indicated deadline. Seeding of events will occur after the scratch deadline has been reached • Scratch cards should be completed and deposited in the scratch box at Clerk of Course by the appropriate deadline.
<p>Swim Offs:</p>	<p>It is the coaches' and swimmer's responsibility to check for ties leading to swim-offs. Swim-offs will be swum immediately following the preliminary session or not more than 45 minutes after the last heat of any event in which any one of these swimmers is competing in that session. Any swimmer not present for a swim-off will be dropped to the lower place.</p>

The exceptions will be sent electronically (by email) within 72 hours after the entry deadline. Coaches will then have 48 hours upon notice of posting to review the psych sheet and notify the host team of any corrections. Coaches may not change an athlete's events or entry times once entries are received by the host team (except as currently state in the SC Swimming P & P where non-conforming time can be changes within 24 hours of notification by the host team to the athlete's coach). Only omissions may be corrected at the published cost of the event.</p>
<p>Proof of Time:</p>	<p>A fine of \$100.00 will be levied against the club (if unattached, against the swimmer) when a swimmer fails to swim a time equal to or faster than the qualifying standard for each event at the long course or short course State Championships and the club (or the swimmer if unattached) is unable to prove, using official results, that he or she has met the qualifying standard in that event in a meet held since January 1, 2021. This fine must be paid (or the time must be proved) within 45 days from the date of notification. If the fine is not paid within the 45 days, it will be doubled. This notification will be made through an exception report that will be generated by the host club and sent with the meet results. The Administrative Vice Chair will enforce the fines.</p> <p>If swimmers participate in a relay, and fail to meet the qualifying standard, their team must demonstrate that the aggregate of the times of the four competing swimmers meets the relay qualifying standard. Otherwise, aforementioned fines will be issued.</p>

Selections will be posted by February 2nd, 2022. We will not accommodate walk-ins at the meet. The dress at the State Championship Meet for Prelims will be a collared, white South Carolina Swimming, sleeved shirt over navy for all officials. The dress at finals will be a collared, red South Carolina Swimming (provided), sleeved shirt over navy pants for all officials. We request that all white shoes be worn at all sessions; please, no open toed shoes of any kind (sandals, flip flops, etc., or feet shoes). Face masks must be worn at all times in the facility and during the sessions. If officials have any questions, they may contact Aimee McMillan officials@sc-swimming.org Officials will meet 1 hour before the start of the meet in the official's room. Officials are required to show proof of current USA Swimming Non-Athlete registration and current USA Swimming Official's credentials. This meet will be an Official's Qualifying Meet. Officials interested in advancing their national level qualifications can obtain the following evaluations at this meet: Stroke and Turn – N2 AND N3, Chief Judge N2 and N3, Starter N2/N3, Deck Referee N2/N3 and Admin Referee N2/N3i. This jury will be comprised of three (3) individuals as follows: one coach, one athlete, and one official. This jury will meet and determine the outcome of any protests affecting the eligibility of any swimmer to compete or to represent any team/organization.</p> <p>A Meet Management Committee shall be established by the Meet Referee prior to entry deadline for the meet and convened prior to publication of timelines. This committee will consist of five (5) persons: (a) one athlete designated by the Senior Athlete Representative; (b) the head coach of the host club; (c) the Meet Director; (d) the Meet Referee; and (e) one Board of Directors member, (Age Group Championship: Age Group Chair; Senior Championship: Senior Chair). A copy of the SCLSC Warm-up Procedures will be available in the coach's packet and posted around the pool.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Coaches are advised to closely supervise their swimmers at all times. • Each team will be assigned a lane/lanes for the specific portion of each warm-up session. • Diving is permitted only during specific warm-up times, as announced. • Swimmers who participate in the meet without a coach present must make arrangements with the host club prior to the start of the meet so that a coach may be assigned to them. • Running and horseplay are both prohibited. • Glass containers and bottles are prohibited inside the pool area. • Glass containers/bottles, alcoholic beverages and tobacco products of any kind are prohibited inside the swimming venue. • Each team should monitor and clean your team area at the conclusion of each session. • Shaving down is not permitted in the facility. • Body paint is not permitted in the facility. • The use of pull buoys, paddles, kickboards, bands, tubing, and other equipment is prohibited. • Any swimmer found to be abusing any area of the facility will be barred from further competition and will also be barred from the facility. The team of any swimmer found to be abusing any area of the facility will be held responsible for any and all repairs resulting from the abuse. • Deck marshals will be assigned to supervise all sessions of the meet and will have the authority to remove any swimmer, coach, parent or club from the pool and facility, if necessary, for not following the facility and meet safety rules. • Only authorized volunteers and working personnel may remain behind the blocks, timing area, and Clerk of Course area during the meet. All others must remain in the designated spectator areas and are not permitted in the racing area unless timing for an event or volunteering with the management of the meet.
