Indoor 20-lane 25-yard competition pool with a moveable bulkhead and 8-lane 25 yard warm down pool with non-turbulent lane lines. Bleacher seating for over 1000. Spectators may bring chairs and tents to use on the outside patios and grass areas. Chairs, food and coolers are not permitted on the pool deck. The water depth of the competition course is seven (7) feet, measured from one (1) meter to five (5) meters, on the starting end of the course, and seven (7) feet, measured from one (1) meter to five (5) meters, at the turn end of the course. The water depth of the warm down course is six (6) feet, measured from one (1) meter to five (5) meters, on the starting end of the course, and four (4) feet, measured from one (1) meter to five (5) meters, at the turn end of the course. The competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C  
Medical supervision will be provided by lifeguard staff. There is an AED onsite.

**Rules:** Meet to be conducted in accordance with the current USA Swimming and SC Swimming Rules and Regulations and information herein. This is a closed meet and only open to any CYSL League Team. CYSL League By-Laws will also govern this meet.  
Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms.  
Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.  
Deck changing is prohibited by USA Swimming and South Carolina Swimming. A first offense will result in the disqualification of the offending swimmer from the next scheduled event. The second offense for the same swimmer will result in the disqualification from the remainder of the meet.

**SWIMWEAR:** No Technical Suit may be worn by any 12 & under USA Swimming athlete member in competition at any Sanctioned, Approved or Observed meet (USA Swimming Rule 102.8.1.1F)  
**MAAPP 2.0:** All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet, acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.

**Athlete Eligibility:** This meet is open to all swimmers and teams currently members of any CYSL and YMCA team in South Carolina. Age is determined on the first day of the meet, January 6, 2024

Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a USA Swimming member coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

**Image Release:** By attending or participating in this competition, you agree to be filmed and photographed by the host club approved photographer(s) and videographer(s) and to allow the right to use names and pictures before, during, or after the meet such as in public psych sheets, heat sheets, and results or featured on the host club or SCLSC website or social media or in public broadcast of the event via television or webcast. Parents and guardians of minor swimmers who do not wish their swimmers to participate in interviews or have individual pictures featured on any media should inform their team's head coach and the Meet Director prior to the start of the meet.

**Entry Fees:** Swimmers may swim up to four individual events and one relay per day. YMCA Only Swimmers fee is \$20 per swimmer.

USA swimming athletes will be assessed:

\$2.00 SCLSC Travel Fund/Program Fee

\$2.00 SCLSC Sport Development Fee

No refunds once entries have been accepted.

No Time Trials offered.

Clubs should submit a Single Check payable to Summerville Family YMCA for the full amount due. All fees must be paid prior to any swimmer entering the pool.

**Meet Format:** All events will be contested as timed finals.  
- Meet management reserves the right to adjust numbers of heats, lanes, entry limits, and Warm up times based on the number of entries. We will only swim the events listed in the meet information.

This is a Closed YMCA Meet, held under the approval of USA Swimming.

Age groups for meet will be 6 & Under, 7-8, 9 & 10 years, 11 & 12 years, 13 & 14 years, and 15 & Older. Clerk of course will be used.

- Genders and age groups may be seeded together but will be scored separate.
- A swimmer who misses their assigned heat will not be entered into another heat unless determined by the Meet Referee and the swimmer may be allowed to swim.
- 1650 & 500 Free... swimmers must provide their own timer & counter.
- 1650 & 500 Free... Positive Check-In 30 minutes prior to the start of the session
- 400 IM...Positive Check-In 30 minutes prior to the start of the session.
- 1650 Free... limited to 10 fastest seeded girls and boys.
- 1650 Free... swimmers must have a time, NT are not accepted.

**Time of Meet:** Meet management reserves the right to adjust warm up times based on number of entries

Warm ups will begin at 10:00 am

- 10:00-10:30 am: Summerville, Sumter, Beaufort
- 10:30-11:00 am: Hartsville, Coastal, Cane Bay

Time of Meet: 11:15 am

**Entries:** Only entries using Standard Data Interchange format (SDIF/SD3) will be accepted. Entry files should be submitted by email on or before the due date. You must also provide an entries list in pdf format and a current roster also in pdf format via mail or email.

Event file can be found on the CYSL web site and also located on SC Swimming web site. SC Swimming does not accept deck registrations, all swimmers entered must be registered at time of entry deadline.

**You must delete any USA Swimming registration numbers from all non-USA Swimming registered athletes for entry purposes.** This can be done under the athlete function on Hy-Tek. If you don't remove non-registered swimmer registration numbers, you'll be charged the registered swimmer LSC fees outlined in the meet information.

**Entries are due by 5 PM on Thursday, December 28, 2023**

**Awards:** Individual Events: Ribbons will be awarded for the 1st through 7th places in individual events. Relay events 1st – 3rd will receive medals. All heat winners will receive a Penguin themed rubber duck. Teams are responsible for picking up ribbons after the meet. Ribbons will NOT be mailed

**Scoring:** Individual events will be scored according to the number of lanes in the facility used for competition. Ten (10) lanes: 11,9,8,7,6,5,4,3,2,1. Relays will be scored at double the points for individual events

**Timing:** Timing and Data Processing will be provided by SportsTiming, Inc. Colorado electronic timing system, with touch pads & plungers, will be used. Stop watches will also be used.

**Coaches Eligibility:** All coaches must be either a current coach member in good standing with USA Swimming and meet all coaching (as proven by Deck Pass credentials) or a current YMCA coach in good standing. Coaches must present their credentials to receive their coaching packet. There will be a coaches meeting 15 minutes prior to the start of the meet. Each team should have at least one representative coach present. Coaches must be a current member in good standing with the YMCA of the USA.

No individuals without credentials shall be allowed behind the blocks or on the deck during meet warm-ups or competition.

**Other Information:** **Officials:** Certified officials willing to work are most welcome. There will be an Officials meeting beginning one (1) hour prior to the start of the session. Officials interested in working the session should report to the hospitality room for the meeting.

- Age as of January 6, 2024 will be used as the competition age per CYSL Swimming Rules.
- There will be no spectator seating on the pool deck.

- The 1650 will be a positive check-in events, limited to the top 10 and will be seeded and swam fastest to slowest.
- The 500 Free & 400 IM will be a positive check-in event.
- Concessions will be made available
- Hard copies of the heat sheet will be provided to coaches at the meet.
- We ask that teams be mindful of their team areas on the pool deck and help to police these areas for trash and mess.
- Warm-up procedures: All coaches are responsible for their swimmers during warm-up. Team lane assignments will be sent out with any updated information prior to start of the meet. The use of pull buoys, paddles, kickboards, bands and tubing is prohibited.

Heat Sheets will be emailed out to all coaches before the meet. We will not have heat sheets available for sale at the meet.
